













I. Preparation / priming NBSS








Set	Reservoir	SWAN Switch
 <p>1 Prime pressure monitoring set.</p>	 <p>2 When filling the reservoir, open it slowly $\frac{3}{4}$ of a turn (270°) anticlockwise and then close again.</p>	 <p>3 Prime SWAN Switch completely and free of air bubbles.</p>
		 <p>4 Move SWAN Switch to pressure monitoring position.</p>

II. Blood sampling with the NBSS

*** Lockable Luer lock systems** are recommended for this application. When using **Luer slip systems**, it must be ensured that they are connected to the side port very carefully, **twisting by 90°**.

 <p>1 Move SWAN Switch to flush position.</p>	 <p>2 Completely open reservoir slowly by turning anticlockwise.</p>	 <p>3 Connect withdrawal container securely.</p>	 <p>4 Move SWAN Switch to sampling position.</p>
 <p>5 Draw blood sample.</p>	 <p>6 Move SWAN Switch to pressure monitoring position.</p>	 <p>7 Disconnect withdrawal container.</p>	 <p>8 Disinfect sampling port. Pay attention to flash-off time!</p>

III. Reinfusion & flushing

 <p>1 Completely close reservoir slowly by turning clockwise.</p>	 <p>2 Flush the NBSS.</p>	 <p>3 Disinfect sampling port.</p>	 <p>4 Move SWAN Switch to flush position.</p>	 <p>5 Flush the NBSS.</p>
 <p>6 Move SWAN Switch to pressure monitoring position.</p>	 <p>7 Control: Check pressure monitoring & display on monitor.</p>
